


The White Villages



Andalucía is the southernmost autonomous community in Peninsular Spain. It is the most populated and the second largest community in the country. The Andalusian autonomous community is officially recognised as a "historical nationality". The territory is divided into eight provinces: Almería, Cádiz, Córdoba, Granada, Huelva, Jaén, Málaga and Seville that also contains the capital city: Seville



Andalucía is home to the hottest and driest summers in Spain, even though in the west the Atlantic ensures that it's relatively wet in the winter, with some areas receiving copious amounts of rainfall. Contrary to what many people think, as a whole, the region has above-average yearly rainfall in the context of Spain.

The name "Andalusia" is derived from the Arabic word Al-Andalus.The toponym al-Andalus is first attested by inscriptions on coins minted in 716 by the new Muslim government of Iberia.The etymology of the name "al-Andalus" has traditionally been derived from the name of the Vandals.

Located in Andalucía you find the only desert in Europe, Tabernas Desert (Almeria). The desert has been used for several series and films, Game Of Thrones included.

2. Popular Carnival of Cadiz

Andalucía is the host of the big festival of Cadiz. It is the most popular festival of Spain and includes music, dancing and a bit carnival competition in the ens of the festival. Don't miss it!
